

National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc. Queen City Metropolitan Chapter (QCMC) Non-traditional Scholarship Application

<u>Purpose</u>

The National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that focuses on improving the lives of Black women and their families. The National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc. Queen City Metropolitan Chapter (NCBW-QCMC) was chartered in Charlotte, NC on September 20, 2009. Our mission is to advocate on behalf of Black women and girls to promote leadership development and gender equity in the areas of health, education, and economic empowerment. We carry out our mission through advocacy work and by offering a variety of programs such as financial literacy classes, advocacy training, mentoring, Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) college fairs, and health awareness events.

NCBW-QCMC is proud to sponsor this scholarship in an endeavor to provide encouragement and financial assistance to Black women who have completed high school and wish to further their postsecondary education. This is a need **and** merit-based scholarship that is specifically for women who have at least a 5-year gap between the time of application and their last enrollment date at an educational institution.

One (1) award in the amount of \$1,000.00 (payable in two (2) installments of \$500). The award will be sent directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment. The awards are non-renewable.

NOTE: Immediate family members of QCMC members are ineligible to apply.

Eligibility

Applicants **must** meet the following criteria to be considered for this scholarship:

- Be a Black woman
- Be a resident of the following counties: Mecklenburg, Cabarrus, Iredell, Lincoln, Gaston, Union, Lancaster (SC), and York (SC)
- Have not been enrolled in high school or an institution of higher learning for at least 5 years
- Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale at the last educational institution that she attended
- Have been accepted into an accredited institution of higher learning: a two to four-year college or university or a technical/vocational school at the time of application (Proof of acceptance such as a copy of your acceptance letter is required)



- Able to demonstrate financial need by documenting the costs of enrollment at the educational institution compared to the applicant's household income and other financial factors or by providing a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Selection Criteria

The Scholarship Committee will take into consideration the following when selecting scholarship recipients:

- Completeness of application packet (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- Community service/involvement
- Strength of personal statement
- Demonstration of financial need
- Prior academic achievement
- Letters of recommendation (2)
- Interview (dates and times will be communicated two weeks in advance)

Application Packet Requirements

Applicants must submit their completed packet to the NCBW QCMC Scholarship Committee by March 15, 2024. The following must be included in the application packet:

- Scholarship Applicant Form
- Applicant Activity Sheet
- Personal Statement
- Official, sealed transcript of grades from previous educational programs if applicable
- Proof of acceptance into an accredited institution of higher learning: a two to four-year college or university or a technical/vocational school at the time of application (i.e. acceptance letter)
- Two sealed letters or recommendation written by members of the community who are not family members
- Copy of completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or other approved documentation demonstrating financial need
